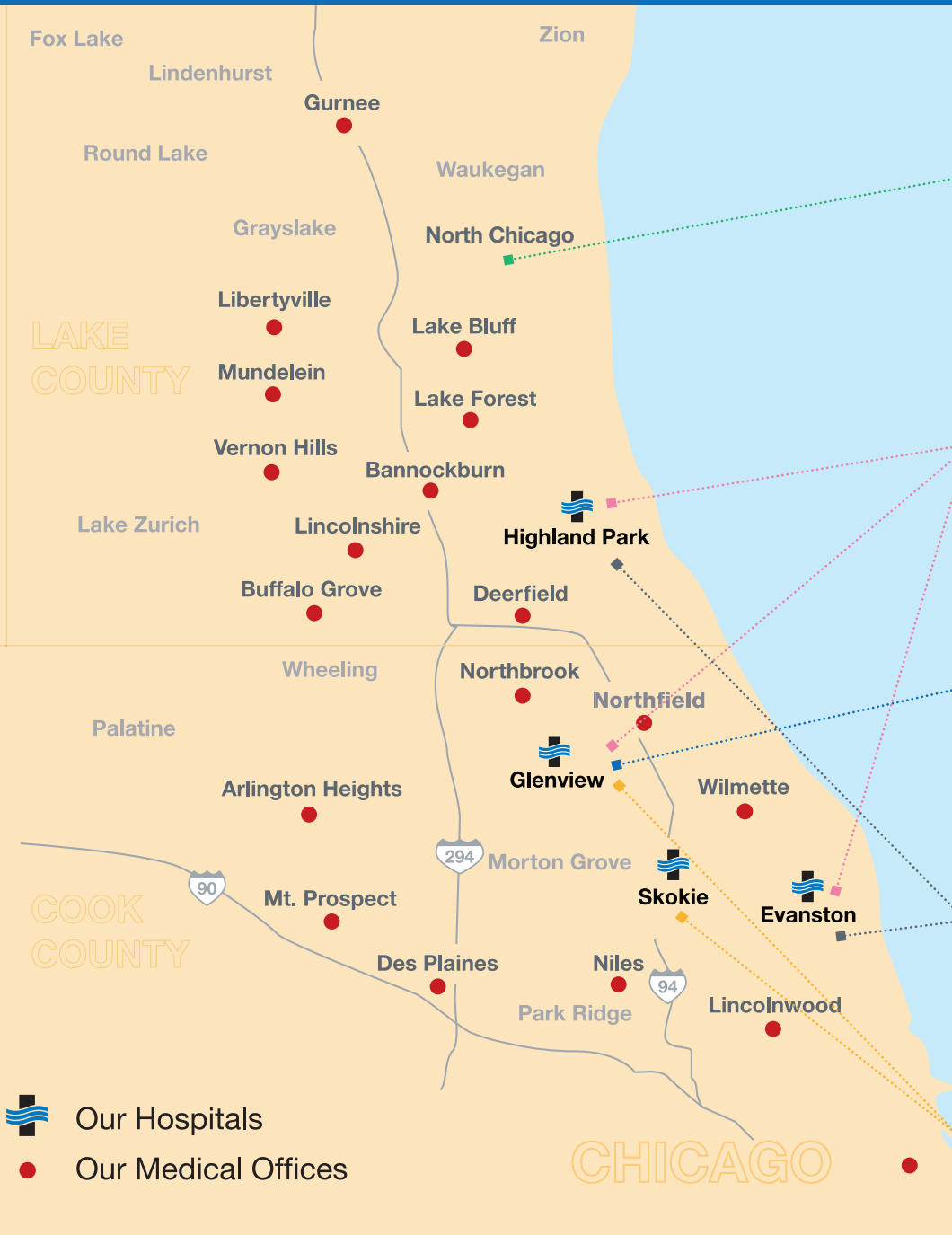

**Be-Well Lake County**  
Provides low-income communities increased access to effective diabetes management, education and lifestyle support resources in Lake County. The Grace Hong Community Garden in North Chicago encourages patients to plant and ultimately harvest a variety of fresh vegetables, yielding produce for patients to take home each week.

**Kellogg Cancer Center Fund**  
Helps cancer patients and their families manage the emotional, practical and financial needs of cancer treatment, helping the most economically vulnerable patients meet basic living needs and enhancing their quality of life.

**Reach Out and Read**  
Supplies new books to children from 6 months to 5 years of age at each visit at the Glenbrook Family Care Center, and encourages clinicians to provide developmentally appropriate advice to parents about reading with their child.

**Perinatal Family Support Center**  
Provides a wide array of services free of charge to women and their families experiencing challenges related to pregnancy, birth, prematurity or perinatal loss, serving 1,650 families last year.

**Eye and Vision Center**  
Hosts ophthalmology clinics for underserved residents, treating 879 pediatric and adult patients last year.

**Care for the Medically Underserved Fund**

General support. Can provide assistance by:

- Helping those in our community with limited financial resources or health coverage by offering emergency and wellness care.
- Providing a range of services from internal medicine and obstetrics/ gynecology to

general surgery, orthopaedics and diabetes education at the Evanston Hospital Community Health Center and Glenbrook Family Medical Clinic.

- Serving adult patients at the Dental Center at Evanston Hospital with primary care dental services and special consultations.

- Providing free care to all students registered for our program at Evanston Township High School Health Center, serving 900 students last year.

**Medication Assistance Program**

Offers aid to patients who need help paying for prescription medication. Last year, more than 23,120 prescriptions were filled.

**Integrative Medicine Sponsor-A-Patient Fund**

Offers free integrative care like mind-body medicine and acupuncture for some of our most vulnerable patients suffering from chronic diseases such as fibromyalgia, multiple sclerosis and chronic pain.
